Of particular significance in this list are the diving beetle *Agabus biguttatus* and the rove beetle *Oxytelus fulvipes*. The former is a Nationally Scarce water beetle associated with fast flowing streams that has only been recorded elsewhere in Warwickshire at Sutton Park (1978) and the latter is a Nationally Scarce rove beetle associated with wetland habitat that is only known from around seven vice counties in England and Wales. The Edgbaston pitfall-trapped specimens represent the first recorded occurrences of this rove beetle species in Warwickshire since 1891. Unfortunately, neither of these beetles were recorded in the current survey. The loss of either or both may be an indication of increasingly contaminated water quality in the case of the former species and of deteriorating wetland habitat in the case of the latter species.

An anomalous record is that of the Noble Chafer, *Gnorimus nobilis*. This is a red data book National BAP species with a restricted distribution centred around the old orchards of Gloucestershire and Worcestershire in the West Midlands region. The larvae feed in the wood mould of decaying fruit trees

and the adults visit flowers. The single specimen reported from Edgbaston was not found strictly on the reserve but instead, was picked up by a golfer on the adjacent golf course. There appears to be no suitable habitat in the vicinity and this record must be viewed as something of an enigma.
